WHAT TO EXPECT AT CENTRAL KIDS



Check-In & Check-Out

Before the service come to the children's wing and check-in your

child. You will receive a name tag for your child and a security tag for pick-up. Afterward you can drop your child off in the classroom or take them to worship until children are released during the prayer of blessing for children.



Wellness Policy

We ask that children are fever free for at least 24 hours before being checked into Central Kids. If your child shows signs of sickness while in a Central Kids environment, we will contact you. Find our full wellness policy here.



Kindergarten-3rd Grade (Treehouse)

Kindergarten through 3rd grade children meet downstairs in the Treehouse for an age appropriate kids service, following the prayer of blessing for children in the service. Children can be picked up for communion.



Allergies

Please communicate any food or substance allergies your child may have when you check your child into Central Kids. We do serve snack in some rooms.



Diaper Changing Policies

Volunteers and staff are trained to wear gloves and sanitize the changing area. Other adults are around during the process and will let you know if your child has been changed.



Toy & Room Cleaning

We wipe down all our toys and surfaces each week. We also remove soiled toys as needed and sanitize each week



Mother's Room/Changing Stations

Changing Tables are located in all the bathrooms on the first floor and in the Mother's Room and the Cry Room bathroom at the top of the stairs behind the sanctuary.



Safety & Security

We only allow background checked volunteers & staff in our children's classrooms. Volunteers will never be left alone with your child. We follow a two adult per room rule.



Crying & Discipline

If a child is having trouble adjusting to the classroom or following the guidelines that have been put in place, our volunteers will first try redirecting the child's behavior. If needed, one of our team members will contact a parent to come and pick-up their child.



Emergency Evacuation Plan

Our church has an emergency evacuation plan in place. In the event of an emergency evacuation, your child will exit the building with trained volunteers and staff to safety. Do not pick up your child from Central Kids during an emergency evacuation unless you are instructed to do so from Church staff.
